

PLAYING UNDER PROTEST



WHAT IS PLAYING UNDER PROTEST?

Sports Teams can challenge the conditions of a fixture if they feel that upon arrival, they do not meet those set by BUCS Guidelines or Fixture Information

HOW DO I RAISE A PLAYING UNDER PROTEST?

Providing a team gives advanced warning to the official in charge, a team is permitted to stop play at an appropriate time (natural break in play) to complete a Playing Under Protest Form.

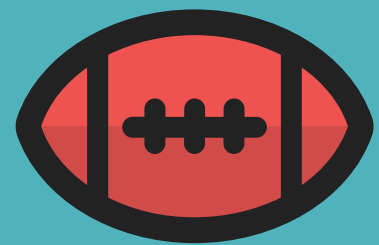


WHAT DO I NEED FOR THE FORM?

You'll need to gather evidence to support your claims. Be that date stamped photographs or videos, or written statements from match officials. You'll also need to get the opposition to sign the form too.

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A PLAYING UNDER PROTEST FORM

You are able to get these forms from the BUCS Website or come and grab one from the SU Office before you head off to your Fixture.



ONCE YOU'VE COMPLETED THE FORM

You will need to submit a Playing Under Protest Form to the SU Office to Sharo or Jamie who will then submit the Playing Under Protest to BUCS.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

Once a Playing Under Protest has been submitted, BUCS will review the Evidence and then make a decision based on the evidence provided by yourselves and the opposition. BUCS will notify the SU of any outcome and then we will pass this onto you.
