- **Career Development & Networking:** Organize career and internship opportunities, enhance skill development workshops and networking.

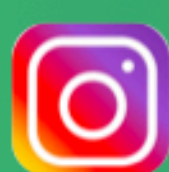

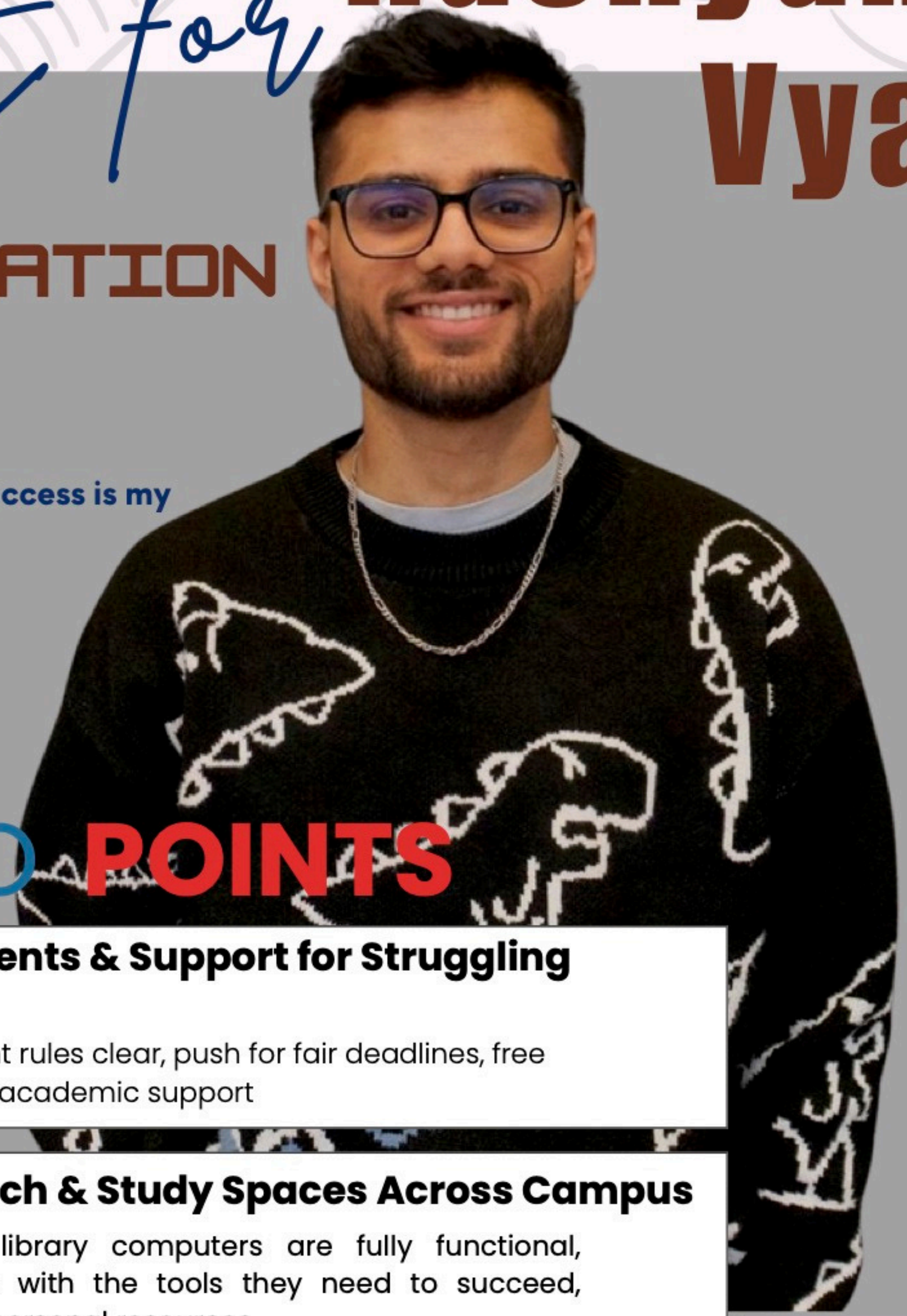

Timetables should be balanced, predictable, and student-friendly. I will work to ensure reasonable class schedules and fairer exam spacing.

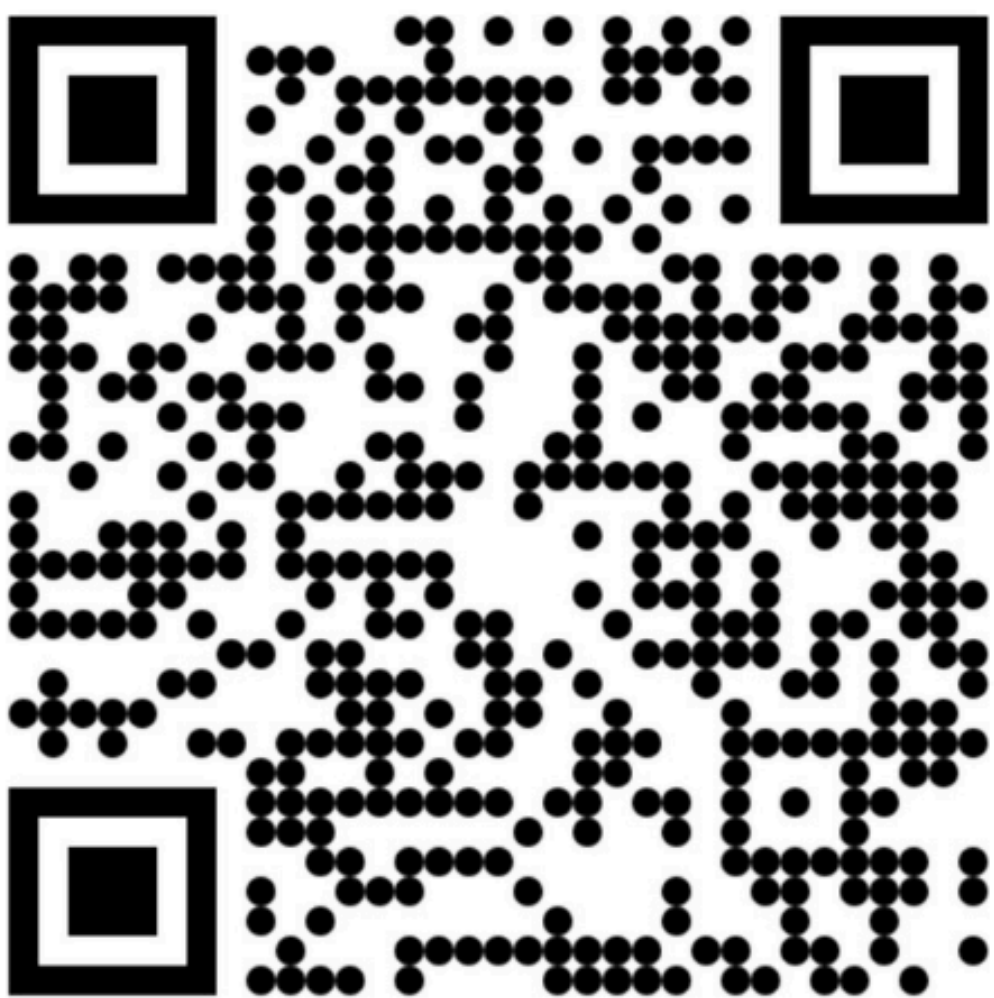
